League Rules:

- Matches will be 3 games, rally scoring 21 points, no cap.
- Any team not ready to start 10 minutes after scheduled time forfeits their first game. 2nd game at 20 minutes and 3rd game at 30 minutes.
- Games will be called 1hr after scheduled start time regardless of score.
- Players can NOT touch the net at any time while the ball is in play.
- No open hand tips, dinks, passes or sets can go over the net. No pushing the ball. Call your own faults.
- Let serves are ok.
- Must be at least 1 girl and not more then 2 guys on the court.
- A girl must touch the ball if there are 3 contacts.
- 1 A level male player permitted per team. No AA level males. All level females are permitted. Players are ranked at the highest-level League or Tournament played in the past 36 months unless prior approval by Volleyball Committee.

- Each team will be responsible for keeping score and overseeing matches when their team number is listed under Work Team to the right of the games. - Subs in Playoffs are only permitted to make a team of 3. Must be equal skilled players and approved 72 hrs in advance.
- Regular players must play 4 matches to be eligible for playoffs and not permitted to sub for other teams.
- Rosters can not be updated after match #3 with the exception of approved emergency situations. Subs can be added through match 7.
- To be eligible for playoffs, you must play 3 matches.
- Subs in Playoffs are only permitted to make a team of 3. If the sub has played 3 matches for that team, they can be considered a regular player.

August 25, 2026 Top 6 Playoffs

- Subs that have not played 3 matches, but are needed to make a team of 3, must be equal skilled players and approved 72 hrs. in advance.
- Rain out policy: We only cancel matches for unsafe conditions such as lighting, heavy downpours or water laying on the courts. In the event of unsafe conditions, all team captains will receive notification via email and/or text message 1 hr. prior to the first match. If any match of the night is called due to unsafe conditions, all games for that night will be removed and not considered for playoffs unless all teams are able to make up games. If unsafe conditions occur for playoffs, the reschedule date will be the next date the courts are available.
- Emergency Rescheduling: All team captains are provided with a Captains List with all details for eligibility and conditions to reschedule a match.
- If unsafe conditions occur for playoffs, the reschedule date will be the next date the courts are available.
- Higher Ranked Male Players=** 1 Higher ranked male player can play this division with restrictions. Underhand serve, no blocking, no jumping, no fingers above the plane of the net. Attacks must be a roll with an obvious arc. **Higher Ranked Male Players must identify themselves at the beginning of the match.**
